5.	Introduction: The panel was introduced to Natalie who is the new Housing Manager for Gloucester City Homes. She joined the meeting to meet everyone and to gain an insight into the way Podsmead Big Local works.	NW
6.	Grant Applications: There are no new grant applications at the moment. It was noted that there was a problem with the online form. It would not allow the information to be submitted. 7.	Community Development & Economic Plan: Iain introduced the process that he has been going through and the various meetings and consultations that had taken place. He has been working with Les and Robyn along with other panel members and the other groups that are established in Podsmead. Due to GCH cancelling their community consultations it was wondered if this would allow for an extension to the report's timeline for submission. It was noted that the local shops were not aware of the impact that the regeneration would have on their business. There was also a lot of questions raised about the community building, what can be done with the building? How would it be funded/costed?
